



ADMISSION ANNOUNCEMENT
UNDERGRADUATE PROGRAMS: FALL - 2019

1. Applications are invited from interested candidates for admission in the following undergraduate programs for the Session Fall 2019:

| Department | No of Seats | Duration of study |

| Bachelor of Science in Computer Science and Engineering (CSE) | 100 | 4 Years |
| Bachelor of Science in Electrical and Electronic Engineering (EEE) | 100 | 4 Years |
| Bachelor of Science in Civil Engineering (CE) | 50 | 4 Years |
| Bachelor of Business Administration (BBA) | 100 | 4 Years |
| Bachelor of Arts (Hons) in English | 50 | 4 Years |
| Bachelor of Law (LLB) | 50 | 4 Years |

2. **Qualification for Admission:** Candidates who have passed HSC or A Level examinations in 2017, 2018 and 2019 are eligible to apply, if he/she fulfills the following criteria:

a. **CSE/EEE/CE:**

(1) SSC/Dakhil and HSC/Alim Examinations: SSC/Dakhil and HSC/Alim or equivalent examination in Science Group with Mathematics, Physics and Chemistry scoring minimum GPA 3.0 for each. The sum total GPA of SSC/Dakhil and HSC/Alim should be minimum **7.0** (with additional subject).

(2) GCE Applicants

(a) O Level: Minimum C Grade in five subjects including Mathematics, Physics and Chemistry (in the scale of A=5, B=4, C=3, D=2 and E=1).

(b) A Level: Minimum C Grade in 2 subjects including Mathematics, Physics/ Chemistry

(c) The sum total of GPA in GCE A and O level should be 6.

(d) The candidates with E grade in any subject will not be considered.

b. **Bachelor of Business Administration(BBA)**

(1) SSC/Dakhil and HSC/Alim Examination: Minimum GPA of 3.00 in SSC/Dakhil and HSC or equivalent examination. The sum total of GPA of HSC/Alim and SSC/Dakhil should be minimum **6.5**.



(2) GCE Applicants

- (a) O Level: Minimum C Grade in five subjects (in the scale of A=5, B=4, C=3, D=2 and E=1).
- (b) A Level: Minimum C Grade in 2 subjects.
- (c) The sum total of GPA in GCE A and O level should be 6.
- (d) The candidates with E grade in any subject will not be considered.

c. **Bachelor of Arts (Hons) in English**

(1) SSC/Dakhil and HSC/Alim Examinations: Minimum GPA of 3.00 in HSC/Alim or equivalent examination. The sum total of GPA of SSC/Dakhil and HSC/Alim should be minimum **6.5** (with additional subject).

(2) GCE Applicants

- (a) O Level: Minimum C Grade in five subjects (in the scale of A=5, B=4, C=3, D=2 and E=1).
- (b) A Level: Minimum C Grade in 2 subjects.
- (c) The sum total of GPA in GCE A and O level should be 6.
- (d) The candidates with E grade in any subject will not be considered.

d. **Bachelor of Law (LL.B)**

(1) SSC/Dakhil and HSC/Alim Examinations: Minimum GPA of 3.00 in HSC/Alim or equivalent examination. The sum total of GPA of SSC/Dakhil and HSC/Alim should be minimum **6.5** (with additional subject).

(2) GCE Applicants

- (a) O Level: Minimum C Grade in five subjects (in the scale of A=5, B=4, C=3, D=2 and E=1).
- (b) A Level: Minimum C Grade in 2 subjects.
- (c) The sum total of GPA in GCE A and O level should be 6.
- (d) The candidates with E grade in any subject will not be considered.

3. Quota for Children of FF: 3% of the total seats are reserved for the children of Freedom Fighters.



4. Selection Procedure for Admission:

a. **Engineering Programs (CSE/EEE/CE).** A Written and MCQ test will be conducted on Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry and English (Comprehension and Functional) as per the syllabus of HSC. The test will be of 100 marks and 2 hours duration. The distribution of marks is given below:

b. Non-Engineering Programs

(1) **Bachelor of Business Administration (BBA).** A written and MCQ test will be conducted on Bangla, English (as per the syllabus of HSC), ICT, General Knowledge and Analytical Ability. The test will be of 100 marks and 2 hours duration. The distribution of marks is given below for different Department students:

*Thirty marks for English shall be divided into two parts i.e. MCQ-10 and Written-20. In the written part, students shall answer two questions. The written questions shall consist of essay, paragraph, or any recent issue. MCQ pattern will be followed in all other parts of the test.

(2) **Bachelor of Arts (Hons) in English.** A written and MCQ test will be conducted on Bangla, English (as per the syllabus of HSC), General Knowledge and Creative Writing Ability. The test will be of 100 marks and 2 hours duration. The distribution of marks is given below:

(3) **Bachelor of Law (LL.B).** The test will be of 100 marks and 2 hours duration. Total Marks will be divided into two parts i.e. MCQ 50 marks and Written 50 marks. The distribution of marks is given below:

5. **Final Selection:** Final Selection will be prepared as per merit basis of the Test. The Details are as under:

(a) **For Engineering Courses:** Selection of departments shall be as per merit.

(b) **For Non Engineering Course:** As per choice.
